Garbage Collection

Let us talk trash. Garbage containers should be to the roadside by 7:30 am on your garbage day. Over the past month, we have seen a lot of loose garbage in the garbage bins. Please ensure all garbage is contained in a bag that is tied. This ensures, the garbage does not spill when it is being dumped into the truck. Finally, please move your garbage bin back after it has been picked up. Leaving your garbage bin at the end of your driveway creates an obstacle for snow removal. Thank you for assisting with this important activity that keeps our community clean and healthy.

COVID-19 Vaccinations and Booster Shots

Northern Health has been working hard to provide COVID-19 vaccinations, including booster shots. I have heard comments about wait times for appointments, so, during a recent call with the Fraser Lake Medical clinic I asked about wait times. Here is what I learned. Covid vaccinations and booster shots are available at the Fraser Lake Medical Clinic on Mondays and Wednesdays. These vaccinations are by appointment only. The Vaccination Van team will set up at the Professional Building, 298 McMillan Avenue (next to Technopure Water) on Saturday and Sunday January 22 and 23rd from 11:00 am to 8:00 pm for vaccination appointments and walk ins. The Vax Van will bring a team of health professionals to Fraser Lake and they hope to be busy. Even if you have an appointment booked for a later date, you may **drop in** at the Professional Building on that weekend for your vaccination or booster. The team will cancel your appointment on your behalf, and you will walk away vaccinated. If you simply need to register for a vaccination, you can go to the Northern Health COVID-19 Vaccine Plan page. Follow the link at the top of the page for COVID-19 Immunization Clinics. The communities where clinics will be hosted are listed in alphabetical order. Scroll down to Fraser Lake & Area. In the "Details" column on the right side of the page is an italicized "registration" link. Have your provincial health care number handy and it will only take a couple minutes to complete the registration.

VFL Communications – Fibre Optic Services

With the arrival of winter, construction on our Broadband project has been mothballed until spring. Significant work was accomplished in the short two months of construction with over 7000 meters of conduit having been installed. Preparatory work also began on the VFL Communications Telecoms yard at 15 Chow-sunket Street where the electronic infrastructure for our new fibre optic service will be housed. While we wait for the return of warmer temperatures, applications have been submitted to both CN Rail and the Ministry of Transportation to permit service to Park Drive residences on the north side of the rail grade and the businesses, Medical Clinic, and residences south of the highway. Construction will resume in late spring.

VFL Communications is a new Telecom company formed through a partnership between the Village of Fraser Lake and CityWest. With the installation of fibre optic infrastructure, our businesses, services providers, and residents will have access to world class high-speed internet, television and phone services. This new service will level the playing field between what urban centers have and what is available in Fraser Lake. Access to government services, healthcare, education, banking, shopping, entertainment and so

much more depend on effective and reliable internet services. It has become integral to many parts of our lives. We would like you to give VFL Communications and fibre optic services a try. For the month of January 2022, we would like to offer those who have not yet registered three months of free 250 mb fibre optic service. Television and phone services are not provided in that offer, but I believe you will find those services to be offered at reasonable and competitive rates. As of February, the offer for a trial period of free 250 mb fibre optic service will drop to two months. By registering early, you help us with our planning. These offers come without obligation or term agreement. We simply want you to try us! If you are interested, please register. If you feel like this is a sales pitch, it is! Over the last number of years, we have heard repeatedly about the need for improved internet service in Fraser Lake. By forging ahead with this solution, we are providing our community with the best quality service available. The service is also partially owned by the Village. Even if you only use the internet for email and television, please consider giving us a try. By doing so, you are supporting your community. If you have an agreement with another internet service provider, we are still happy to provide a three-month free trial of fibre optic service. Please call for further details.

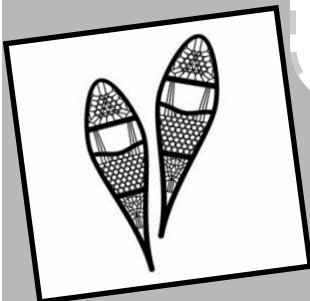


Snow Removal

Snow, snow everywhere -The recent snowfalls have kept our Public Works team scrambling to keep up. They have done a great job keeping our roads cleared and the snow piles pushed back. As a courtesy to our residents, our crews push heavy accumulations of snow that have been left across the end of driveways following street clearing. This service is provided as time allows. The service is intended to assist residents with the sometimes-immovable windrows of snow that can happen following the pass of the grader or other snow clearing machinery. However, as a courtesy service, we will not obligate ourselves to a specific timetable for when the end of your driveway will be cleared.

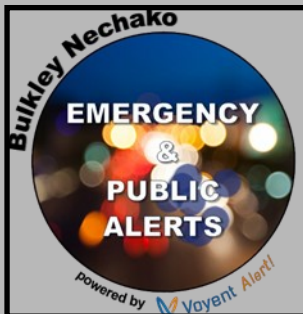
When snow clearing does not result in a significant accumulation of snow across the end of your driveway, we will leave clearing of that snow to the property owner. On weekends, our crew does not clear the end of driveways unless there are exceptional circumstances. If we have a big snowfall and the plow furrow created by snow clearing activities is extreme, like a good neighbor, our crews will stay and help clear the end of driveways. Otherwise, streets are cleared on the weekends and the plow furrow at the end of your driveway will have to wait until a weekday.

This winter there are five snow clearing companies available to residents and business owners who need snow clearing services for your driveway or property. We have listed those companies holding a business license on the Village website. Lester LePoidevin, Wekare Construction, Ian McLean, Dave Sansom and Hurry Help all provide snow clearing services.
